MEMO: "News (Exchange Technology) Summit"

Memo on a meeting of IPTC members to outline a summit of parties involved in providing and using/implementing technology for news exchange.

Participants: Stéphane Guérillot, Misha Wolf, Laurent Le Meur, Michael Steidl

Date: 2003-06-05

Place: Aarhus, Denmark

Goal: Companies in the news industry have to deal with several standards for exchanging news, on first sight they all provide some basic functionality of "controlled transfer of news from one place to another".

Therefore an overview of the different standards showing the specific features making them unique for specific purposed and their ability to interact would be of advantage for both the "makers" of the standards and those who use and implement them.

Therefore IPTC proposes to hold a summit of those involved parties.

Summit outline:

Mobile communication industry

Online content providers

Printed news: Newspapers, magazines

Picture libraries

Public Discussion (~ 1 hour): what steps have to be taken to get the "best of all worlds" for the sake of hassle free news exchange.

What should and what could be done to provide best interaction between the various standards.

Goal: "Liaison committee" for considerations and recommendations

Hosts/Supporters of this initiative:

IPTC

OASIS (as IPTC is member of OASIS and they could probably host the "Liaison Cttee") IDEAlliance as hosts of the XML Conference and body of two standards.

Budget:

As low as possible, no funds allocated at IPTC to this initiative currently.

It should be understood that common costs should be shared among the hosts and hopefully might be covered by a sponsor and specific costs (like travelling) should be covered by the respective parties.
