## 4.2 AP: re-introduction of the “data-location” element

NITF 2.5 had two attributes of <media-reference> to stand for the address/ID/URL of an externally-stored media object (a photo or video clip, for example):

source  
data-location

NITF 3.0 took data-location out (October, 2001)

Chuck Tichenor said AP would highly appreciate to have this element “back” in the specifications for compatibility reasons.

## 4.3 CCI: Clarify Email Address use

Publishers often render document authors with hyperlinks to their email addresses like:

By Joe Reporter

NITF Recommendation:

By <person idsrc="email" value="[joe@coolmedia.com](mailto:joe@coolmedia.com)">Joe Reporter</person>

</byline>

The Chairman admitted the tutorial should be more specific on this and he will update it to point out how this could be done right – in several ways.

## 4.4 Future steps

The Chairman said he is preparing an update to NITF 3.3 and he hopes to have a vote on this at the AGM in May.

After that he will start work on creating an XML Schema for NITF.

Hearing this it was discussed if DTD-validated instances and XML-Schema-validated instances of NITF will mix well.

Misha Wolf asked whether IPTC has a policy on namespaces

Laurent Le Meur said the use of namespaces for NewsML is outlined in the new Guidelines.
