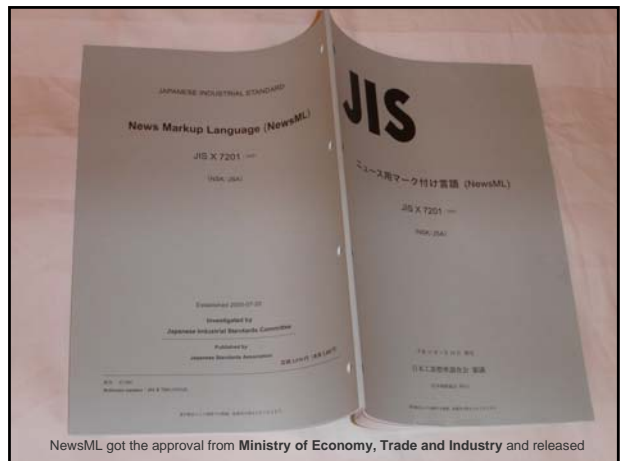

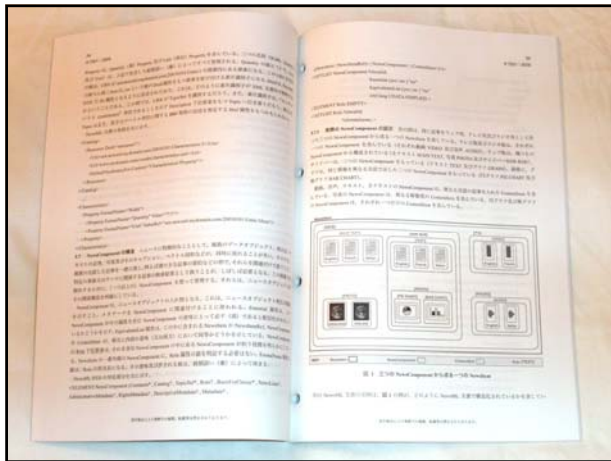
NewsML1.2 Released as JIS X7201 : 2005 Japan Industrial Standard

NewsML got the approval from Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry and released



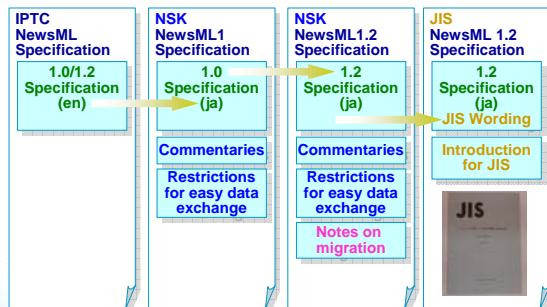
Types of JIS Standards

- JIS has same kind of standard levels, same as ISO
- JIS-TR (Technical Report)**
 - Just a Report
- JIS-TS (Technical Specification)**
 - One of specification in many of one purpose
- JIS (Formal Standard)**
 - Only one standard for one purpose

NewsML

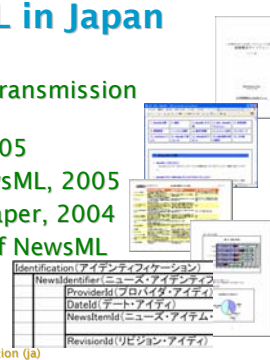
- NewsML has already been widely using in Japan, so it was expected as real standard

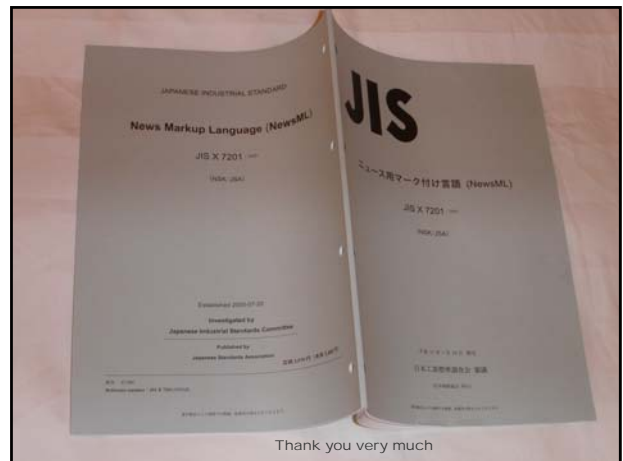
